

Along the Shore of the St. Lawrence Tour

Four Days and Three Nights

DAY ONE:

4:00 pm Check into Capt. Thomson's Resort in downtown Alexandria Bay
6:00 pm Dinner at Riley's Restaurant.

DAY TWO:

8-9:30 am Buffet breakfast at Riley's Restaurant.
10 am-12:15 pm Two Nation Sightseeing Cruise on board Uncle Sam Boat Tours located adjacent to the resort. The most comprehensive tour through the heart of the 1000 Islands.
12:15-2:10 pm Self-guided tour of Boldt Castle, its out buildings and grounds during which time your guests will enjoy their boxed lunches.
The five-acre island is fully handicapped accessible, has complete restroom facilities, a gift shop and a food and beverage concession. There are six impressive structures to explore – Boldt Castle, Power House, Alster Tower, Hennery, Arch and a stone gazebo. Exhibits in the various structures and a 15-minute video presentation offer a look into the lifestyle of George and Louise Boldt, along with a history of the 1000 Islands region and the ongoing restoration efforts on the island.
2:10/2:40 pm Return shuttles from Heart Island to Alexandria Bay
Free afternoon
4:30-5:30 pm Winery Tour and tasting at the Thousand Islands Winery just 4 miles away from the resort.
6:30 pm Dinner at the Edgewood Resort located just outside the village of Alexandria Bay

DAY THREE:

8 – 9:30 am Buffet breakfast at Riley's Restaurant.
10 am-1:15 pm Singer Castle cruise and guided tour. Boxed lunches will be enjoyed on board the tour boat during the return trip up river to Alexandria Bay.
Enjoy a guided tour of this newest attraction in the 1000 Islands located 11 miles downriver from Alexandria Bay. The castle was commissioned by Frederick Gilbert Bourne, a self-made millionaire (president of the Singer Sewing Machine Company), and designed by Earnest Flagg who based his design from a drawing found in the book 'Woodstock' written by Sir Walter Scott. The castle features a granite arched Great Room complete with a 1700s trunk and suits of armor, a library with Mr. Bourne's personal writing desk from Vienna, a core of spiral passageways, and many original furnishings.
2:00 pm Depart on board your motorcoach for Cape Vincent
2:40 pm Stop at the NYS Fisheries Station to view the many fish species common to Lake Ontario and the St. Lawrence River and learn about NY State's conservation programs in the Great Lakes. Five large viewing tanks are complemented by several displays relating to the area's fisheries and the DEC's management of the resources. The aquarium, including the restroom, is handicapped accessible. If a request is made in advance, a staff member can be available to make a presentation to your group.
3:40 pm Depart for the short 5 mile trip out to Tibbetts Point and the Lighthouse
5:30 pm Dinner at The Clipper Inn, Clayton NY

DAY FOUR:

7 – 8:30 am Breakfast at Riley's Restaurant.
8:30 am Check out of the resort
8:45 am Depart for Clayton, NY
9 am-11 am Arrive in Clayton NY (11 miles from Alexandria Bay) for a tour of the Antique Boat Museum and George Boldt's House Boat.

The museum is dedicated to collecting, preserving, studying, and interpreting objects related to the freshwater nautical history of small craft (less than 100 feet) throughout North America, with emphasis on the St. Lawrence River and the surrounding area; to maintaining and using the resulting collection of boats, related artifacts, documents, and information to enhance public appreciation and understanding of the region's nautical heritage, including the evolution of design, propulsion, and construction methods, and the influence of boats on the area's social and cultural fabric; and to providing a research facility, encouraging research, publications, educational programs, and public events related to the freshwater nautical history of the area.
